
# **Holiday Décor Assembly, Use & Care Instructions**

**STORAGE TIPS**: We suggest saving the carton for storing your item. Store in a cool, dry area where the temperature does not exceed 100°F.



#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 1. Installation

- You will assemble the lamp base and lamp post from the top to the bottom.
- First, use four screws to join the square base (10) and the lamp base (9) together.
- To stabilize the street lamp, add the base trim (7) to the lamp base (9). **Note:** If the globe lantern is used outdoors and the lamp base (9) can be secured with the included ground nails (8), the base trim (7) is unnecessary.
- Assemble the lamp post by joining the two lamp post pieces (3) with the lamp post joint (12). **Note:** Each screw thread must be tightly screwed, or the lamp post will become unstable.
- Screw the assembled lamp post to the square lamp base (10). **Note:** Every screw thread must be tightened, or the lamp post may lean.
- Lay the assembled lamp post and base down on the floor to thread the power wire (6) through the lamp base and lamp post. After drawing out the wire's connector through the top of the lamp post and holding it securely, set the lamp post upright on its base, letting the wire hang over the top for now.
- Attach the lamp top (1) to the lamp holder (2).
- Draw out the wire connector to the power wire (14) of the lamp holder, then connect it tightly to the power wire hanging out of the assembled lampost. Put the joined connectors and their wires into the lamp post (3). **Note:** At this time, it will be better to ask another person to hold the lamp holder (2) for you.
- Carefully rotate the lamp holder (2) to fasten it securely on the top of the lamp post (3). **Note:** The screw thread should be tightened as far as possible. The direction of the lamp holder (2) can be slightly adjusted to make it match the direction of the lamp base (9).
- Place your assembled globe lantern in its designated space where it will not be knocked down. If it will be outdoors, please secure it to the ground using the included ground nails (8).
- Join the connectors of the extended wire (5) to the power wire (6) coming out of the base and the adaptor (4).
- Make sure the connectors and all parts are tightly screwed together.
- Plug the adaptor (4) into an indoor power source.

#### If the globe lantern is used outdoors, please read and complete the instructions below:

- Screw the nut at the top of the lamp holder tightly to ensure this part is waterproof.
- All connection points (1 and 2, 2 and 3, 3 and 12, 12 and 3, 3 and 10, 10 and 9) must be screwed tightly to avoid water and electricity leakage.
- The adapter itself is not waterproof. The connecting point between the adapter and main power MUST be located indoors, free from rain and snow, to avoid electricity leakage and electric shock risk.
- The lamp support ends are equipped with a drip hole, and this hole should be unobstructed.
- The lamp holder should be kept vertical to keep it waterproof.

#### 2. Decorate and enjoy

- Place the plaque (11) and the wreath (13) on the lamp post's upper part. (For outdoor installation, the decorations do not have to be attached.)
- Turn on the switch. You should see the snowflakes inside the lantern whirling around and hear the music playing.

**Music** can be controlled by the switch and turned off when not needed.

- I Music and animation are turned on.
- II Off
- **III** Animation is turned on (music off).

# **WARNING**

- 1. This product is for indoor use only. Do not place in direct sunlight.
- 2. This product is for decoration only and is not a toy. Please use caution with children under the age of 8.
- 3. Do not position the decoration near candles, sources of heat, or in direct sunlight.
- 4. The decoration cannot be connected to the power supply directly.
- 5. Do not break, cut, or alter the power cable.
- 6. Do not attempt to repair the wiring with staples or nails.
- 7. Do not place the cable under a carpet or rug as it may get damaged.
- 8. Ensure that the cable is in a secure location where it is not a hazard.
- 9. Do not connect the decoration to the power supply while it is still in the packaging.
- 10. Please switch off the transformer when not in use.
- 11. Do not leave electric decoration unattended while operating in the ON position.
- 12. Do not overload the transformer.
- 13. Decoration should be on a level, stable surface to prevent it from falling over.
- 14. This product is fragile and should be assembled with care.
- 15. The product is for indoor use only and is not suitable for outdoor or any location with drafts.
- 16. Please follow the below steps and requirements specified in the instruction to ensure safety and reliability during the installation.
- 17. Use caution with children under the age of 8. Children should keep a safe distance to avoid inhaling snow particles and possible suffocation.









#### 1-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

"Limited" Warranty Program

For a period of one (1) year after purchase, Fraser Hill Farm ("Manufacturer") will either repair or replace defective components in accordance with this Limited Warranty.

#### Sales and use taxes, plus shipping and handling charges are the responsibility of the consumer.

This warranty is between Manufacturer and the original purchaser and is valid only when accompanied by the original purchaser's sales receipt showing original date of purchase and location of purchase. Replacements under this warranty revert back to the date of original purchase for future warranty.

Manufacturer or its authorized dealer can accept or reject warranty claims based on its findings. This warranty applies in normal residential use only, where an issue with the product is due to a defect in material or workmanship. Manufacturer can make substitutions as required of materials, components, and sub-components of comparable value and utility. This warranty is limited to product repair or replacement (to be determined solely by Manufacturer). Warranty return is limited to only the single affected component.

This warranty covers only manufacturing defects and does not cover normal wear and tear, abuse or misuse, including: water damage, chemical damage, exposure to extreme heat or cold, abrasion or excessive weight. This product is intended to be used with standard ornaments only. This warranty is invalid if the product is not used for intended purpose. Manufacturer disclaims liability for any aspect of installation and any inconvenience caused by a defective part or component.
